Quantified Evolution Plus Fund (QEVOX) received a 3-Star Overall Morningstar Rating™ as of June 30, 2026, in the US Fund Tactical Allocation category. The Morningstar Rating™ is based on a fund's risk-adjusted return relative to other funds in its Morningstar Category and evaluates performance over three-, five-, and ten-year periods, when applicable. As of June 30, 2026, the fund was rated against 225 US Fund Tactical Allocation funds for the three-year period, 202 funds for the five-year period, and 145 funds for the ten-year period. The Fund received a 3-Star Overall Rating, a 4-Star Rating for the three-year period, and a 3-Star Rating for the five-year period. Ratings are calculated monthly and are subject to change. 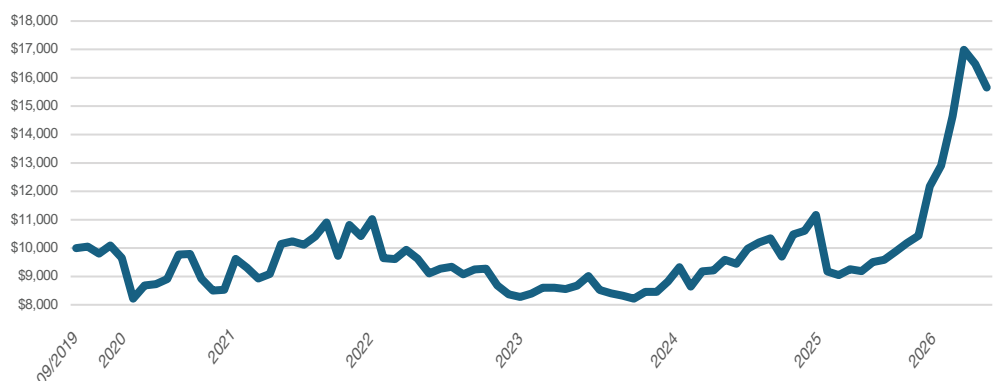

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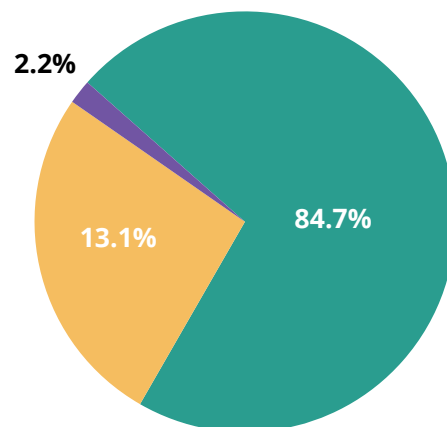
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Portfolio Allocations

Alpha measures the difference between an investment's expected returns based on its beta and its actual returns. The greater the standard deviation, the greater the investment's volatility. The Sharpe ratio indicates the reward per unit of risk by using standard deviation and excess return. The higher the Sharpe ratio, the better the investment's historical risk-adjusted performance.
