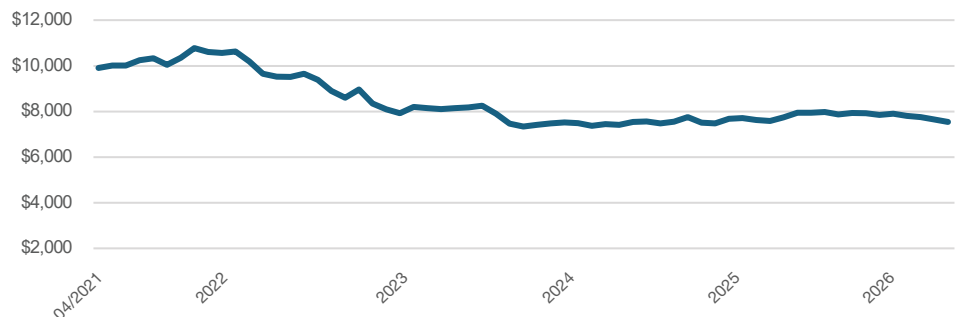

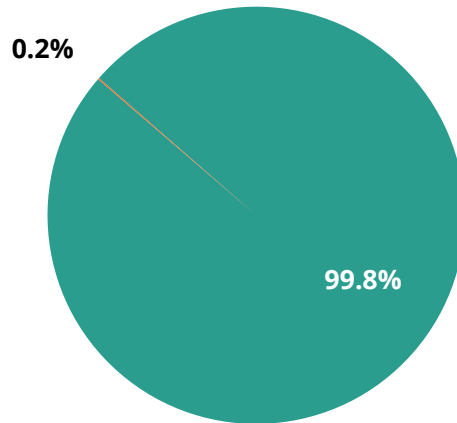

The higher the Sharpe ratio, the better the investment's historical risk-adjusted performance.
